In order to support the Ukrainian citizens fleeing the war and reaching the territory of Alba County, the "Refugee Department" was set up within Alba County Centre for Management and Coordination of Intervention, which became operational on March 4.

The Refugee Department operates 24 hours a day, and it is available to the public, institutions, companies or non-governmental organizations. On March 17, the county information point was opened on the A1 high

way, km 316 - right, located within the commune of Pianu de Jos; it was set up to come to the aid of Ukrainian citizens, to all those affected by the armed conflict in Ukraine, and transiting or destined for Alba County.

In order to achieve this objective, Alba County Council, together with the subordinated institutions - *Augustin Bena* Culture Centre and Alba SALVAMONT - SALVASPEO Service - brought its contribution in terms of logistics. 





A FUTURE THEME PARK, NEAR POIANA INIMII / HEART'S MEADOW

Located in a natural setting of special beauty, overlooking Piatra Craivii, the oak forest near the village of Bucerdea Vinoasa is, for Ighiu City Hall and Alba County Council, an opportunity to develop a theme park, through a future partnership.

The theme park will feature elements from a Dacian village, but will also have the content of an adventure park with climbing and zip-lining activities, tourist orientation routes, cycling route, and other specific and related activities, representing a pleasant way to spend free time with family or friends.

This park is intended to be an attraction of the area, being located in the immediate vicinity of Poiana Inimii / Heart's Meadow, a symbolic image for the county's tourism.



ANCIENT TRADITIONS

FÂRȘANG'S HOLIDAY IN RIMETEA

Celebrated from generation to generation, since the time of the Great Church Schism, the burial of Fârșang is a ceremonial that marks the end of winter and the transition to spring.

The ceremony took place on February 26, in Rime-

tea, where the streets of the village are crossed by a "hearse" in which is the coffin with all the evils and troubles gathered between the Epiphany and the fasting of Easter.

Rimetea village is one of the main tourist attractions on the Apuseni Transcul-

tural route, which impresses with the uniqueness of its houses, which also gave it the status of a monument village. From Rimetea, tourists can travel on tourist routes on Piatra Secuiului or to the noble fortress of Colțești.





PARTNERSHIP FOR THE MODERNIZATION OF THE NATIONAL ROAD 14B

The most important road infrastructure work at the level of Alba County in 2022



The most important road infrastructure work at the level of Alba County this year aims at modernizing and rehabilitating DN 14B, between Teiuș and Blaj. Following the decision taken at the level of Alba County Council for the adoption of decisions of local council and county council within a partnership between Alba County Council and Blaj, Teiuș, Crăciunelu and Mihalț town halls, a protocol was signed on March

15, with CNAIR, for financing the works through the Transport Operational Program 2021-2027. The meeting was attended by Ion Dumitreț, Alba County Council President, and Vice President Marius Hațegan, as well as Mirela Vasile Hălălai, Teiuș Mayor, Gheorghe Valentin Rotar, Blaj Mayor, Flavius Breaz, Mihalț Commune Mayor and Lenuța Bubur, Crăciunelu de Jos Commune Mayor.

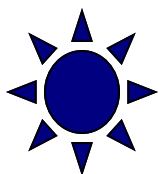




MARCH 27 - THE UNION OF BESSARABIA WITH ROMANIA

Alba County Council, together with Alba Iulia City Hall, the Local Action Groups on Mureș and Târnave, Metaliferi Mountains, Trascău and Muntele Mare, Țara Secașelor Alba - Sibiu, Ampoi Valley, Mureș Valley, organized, between March 25-27, the 12th edition of the Gardener's Fair, in the ditches of Alba Carolina Fortress, in Alba Iulia.

It is an event to promote local products in the field of growing flowers, shrubs, fruit trees and decorative plants, and dedicated to all gardening lovers, professionals or amateurs. On this occasion, a wide range of products was exhibited: seeds, bulbs, shrubs, fruit and ornamental trees, decorative plants, phytosanitary products, garden furniture and accessories, tools and equipment for the maintenance of gardens and green spaces.

The star event of the spring in Alba Carolina Fortress, the fair was a great success, with more than 3,000 visitors, who either took home with them plants, something of the color and scent of spring, or, at least, spent moments of relaxation among flowers or were receptive to the advice of specialists. Over 40 exhibitors made this fair a true spectacle of nature.
